(PURSUANT TO SECTION 219 OF THE ENTERPRISE ACT 2002) IN  
RELATION TO THE CONSUMER PROTECTION FROM UNFAIR TRADING  
REGULATIONS 2008 AND OTHER CONSUMER RELATED LEGISLATION**

**SECTION 1**

I

of 333 Bristol Road, Gloucester, GL2 5DN hereby give a written Undertaking sought by them pursuant to section 219 of the Enterprise Act 2002 for myself (and on behalf of Cheap Car Trade Centre);

- (a) that I will not as Cheap Car Trade Centre or under any other trading name (whether by officers, employees or agents or otherwise) continue or repeat the conduct described in paragraphs 1-8 of Section 2 below;
- (b) that I will not as Cheap Car Trade Centre or under any other trading name (whether by officers, employees or agents or otherwise) engage in such conduct in the course of business; and
- (c) that I will not as Cheap Car Trade Centre or under any other trading name (whether by officers, employees, agents or otherwise) consent to or connive in the carrying out of such conduct by:
  - (i) any body corporate of which I am (or purport to act as) a director, manager, company secretary or other similar officer or a person purporting to act in such capacity;
  - (ii) any partnership (whether limited liability partnership or not) in which I am a partner; and
  - (iii) any business in which I have a controlling interest.

## SECTION 2

**The following is conduct referred to in Section 1 above:**

1. **Contravening** Regulation 5(4)(b) of the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 by conducting a commercial practice that is a misleading action as defined in the regulations in respect of the main characteristics of the product.
2. **Contravening** Regulation 5(4)(c) of the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 by conducting a commercial practice that is a misleading action as defined in the regulations in respect of the extent of the traders commitments.
3. **Contravening** Regulation 5(4)(k) of the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 by conducting a commercial practice that is a misleading action as defined in the regulations in respect of the consumer's rights or the risks he may face.
4. **Contravening** Regulation 5(4)(g) of the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 by conducting a commercial practice that is a misleading action as defined in the regulations in respect of the after-sale customer assistance concerning the product.
5. **Contravening** Regulation 5(4)(r) of the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 by conducting a commercial practice that is a misleading action as defined in the regulations in respect of the results and material features of tests or checks carried out on the product.
6. **Contravening** Section 14(2) of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 (as amended) by selling goods that are not of satisfactory quality.
7. **Contravening** Section 4 of the Business Names Act 1985 by failing to provide business name and address details on business invoices and receipts.
8. **Contravening** the Misrepresentations Act 1967 by inducing consumers to enter into contracts by making false representations to them without reasonable grounds for believing them to be true.
