

CONSUMER CREDIT ACT 1974

I, Ray Watson, Director of the Consumer Credit Group in the Office of Fair Trading ('the OFT') and a member of the OFT's staff, being authorised in that behalf in writing by the OFT pursuant to paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 to the Enterprise Act 2002, hereby give general notice pursuant to section 22(8) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974 that under section 29(1) of that Act the OFT has renewed the group licence issued under section 22(1) of that Act granted on the 3 February 2007 to the following group:

Provision of non-commercial credit information services (including non-commercial credit repair)

The licence is valid for a period of 5 years from 3 February 2009.
