

CONSUMER CREDIT ACT 1974

I, Ray Watson, Director of the Consumer Credit Group in the Office of Fair Trading ('the OFT') and a member of the OFT's staff, being authorised in that behalf in writing by the OFT pursuant to paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 to the Enterprise Act 2002, hereby give general notice pursuant to section 29(6) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974 that the group licence issued to The National Association of Citizens Advice Bureaux, Myddelton House, 115-123 Pentonville Road, London N1 9LZ, which expires on 2 August 2009, has been renewed by the OFT on application by the Association.

The licence is in respect of all those Citizens Advice Bureaux which are from time to time registered with the National Association of Citizens Advice Bureaux, to carry on the business of:

Non-commercial debt-adjusting
Non-commercial debt-counselling
Provision of non-commercial credit information services (including non-commercial credit repair)

The licence is valid for a period of 5 years and commences on 3 August 2009.
