The Office of Fair Trading (OFT) hereby gives general notice pursuant to section 6(2) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974 (the 'Act') that:

Form of application for a validation order


From 1 August 2009, application for a validation order shall be made in the form OFT 1083 (entitled 'Application for an Order to validate agreements under sections 40(2), 148(2) or 149(2) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974') and submitted in hard copy, which may be obtained from the OFT in paper form or downloaded in its entirety from the OFT website. In each case the application shall be accompanied by all fees, documents and information required to be provided at the time the relevant form is submitted.

Note:

Duty to keep OFT informed of all relevant information after an application has been submitted

All applicants must, under section 6(7) of the Act, after an application has been made and before it is determined, notify the OFT, giving details, of any relevant information or document which supersedes the original, provided in relation to the above applications. They should also advise the OFT if they become aware of any error or omission in any information or document forming part of their application.

This Notice supersedes General Notice 54 which is hereby cancelled. With effect from 1 August 2009, forms CC5/96, CC6/96 and CC7/96 are no longer in use.
