

Consumer Credit Act 1974

Group Licence

The Office of Fair Trading in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the *Consumer Credit Act 1974* hereby grants a group licence to:

The National Federation of Enterprise Agencies (NFEA), 12 Stephenson Court, Fraser Road, Priory Business Park, Bedford MK44 3WJ.

The licence is in respect of full and associate members of the NFEA which have been approved by the Secretary of State under section 79(4) of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1988 (or the corresponding provision at section 48(4) of the Finance Act 1982) and referred to in that section as an 'approved local enterprise agency' (ALEA): and

- (a) whose sole or principal objective is the promotion or encouragement of industrial and commercial activity or enterprise in a particular area in England with particular reference to encouraging the formation and development of small businesses; or
- (b) one of whose principal objectives is that set out in the paragraph (a) above and which maintains a fund specified by the Secretary of State (separate from any other funds maintained by it) which is applied solely in pursuance of that objective.

To carry on the business of:

- C Credit brokerage, and
- D Debt-Adjusting and Debt-Counselling.

Limited to activities carried on by approved members of the NFEA in pursuance of the objectives mentioned in paragraphs (a) and (b) above.

This Licence is valid for a period of 5 years and commences on 20 January 2008.
